



**MICKEY MOUSE LIVING TRUST**

**Part 1 – Creation**

1.1 Identification; Definitions

I, MICKEY MOUSE, of ORLANDO, NH, declare myself the creator of the “MICKEY MOUSE LIVING TRUST” (“Trust”).

1.2 Transfer of Property

I transfer all property to this Trust which can be transferred to them in the Trust.

1.3 In the event at any time there is more than one trustee, any trustee

**Part 2 – During My Life**

2.1 Use of Trust Property

During my life, the Trustee may use the Trust property for my benefit as I direct.

2.2 Ending or Changing the Trust

In the event I change or end this Trust, I will do so in writing and sign in the presence of two witnesses and a notary.

**Part 3 – After I Die or Become Unable to Act**

3.1 Use of Trust Property (If Unable to Act)

The Trustee shall use the Trust property for my health, support, or maintenance, and may consult with a disability/Medicaid attorney.

3.2 Ending or Changing the Trust

This Trust cannot be changed. If the Trustee determines that the benefits of ending this Trust outweigh its continuation, the Trustee may end the Trust and divide the property according to the Trust Property Division & Rules sections below.

3.3 Next Trustees

Trustee Shall Control Both Physical & Digital Assets: The person below (listed in order of preference) shall be the Next Trustee of the Trust. The Next Trustee shall have all the powers, and be subject to the duties, written in the Uniform Trust Code (NH RSA 564-B:8-815 & 816 (NH Trustee Powers)), as amended from time to time, as well as the Revised Uniform Fiduciary Access

The Trustee: a) shall not require any bond; b) shall not be responsible for any good faith error(s) in judgment; and c) may receive reasonable payment for services.

3.4 Debts, Taxes, Expenses

The Trustee shall pay my debts, taxes, and expenses from the Trust. In the event the Trust is not able to pay them, the Trustee shall inform the Personal Representative(s) named in my Will.

3.5 Trust Property

The Trustee shall divide the Trust property as soon as reasonably possible, within one year after my death, as written in the Trust Property Division & Rules sections below. The Trustee’s decision on this division shall be final.

**Part 4 – Trust Property Division**

4.1 Physical Property

High Value & Special Physical Gifts

If I have listed any of my property as High Value & Special Physical Gifts in separate writing(s), give these gifts to those listed. No substitute gifts shall be made, unless the Trustee determines in good faith that I would have wanted the person to receive the value of the gift. Gifts of property secured by loan at the time of my death shall be gifted subject to the loan, unless the Trustee determines in good faith that I would have wanted the loan paid by the Trust.

Such gift shall be counted towards a person’s total gifts under this Trust, unless: a) I have instructed that the gift does not “Reduce Other Gifts;” or b) the person declines the gift. If the person declines the gift, or if the person dies before I do, then the gift may be sold as the Trustee sees fit. If the value of the gift exceeds what the person otherwise would have received from my Trust, the person shall not pay the difference.

Other Physical Property


If I have listed any of my other physical property in separate writing(s), give this property to those listed. No substitute gifts shall be made, unless the Trustee determines in good faith that I would have wanted the person to receive the value of the gift. Divide all remaining physical property other than real estate among the Included People who benefit from The Heart of my Estate, as they shall agree. If they cannot agree within six months,



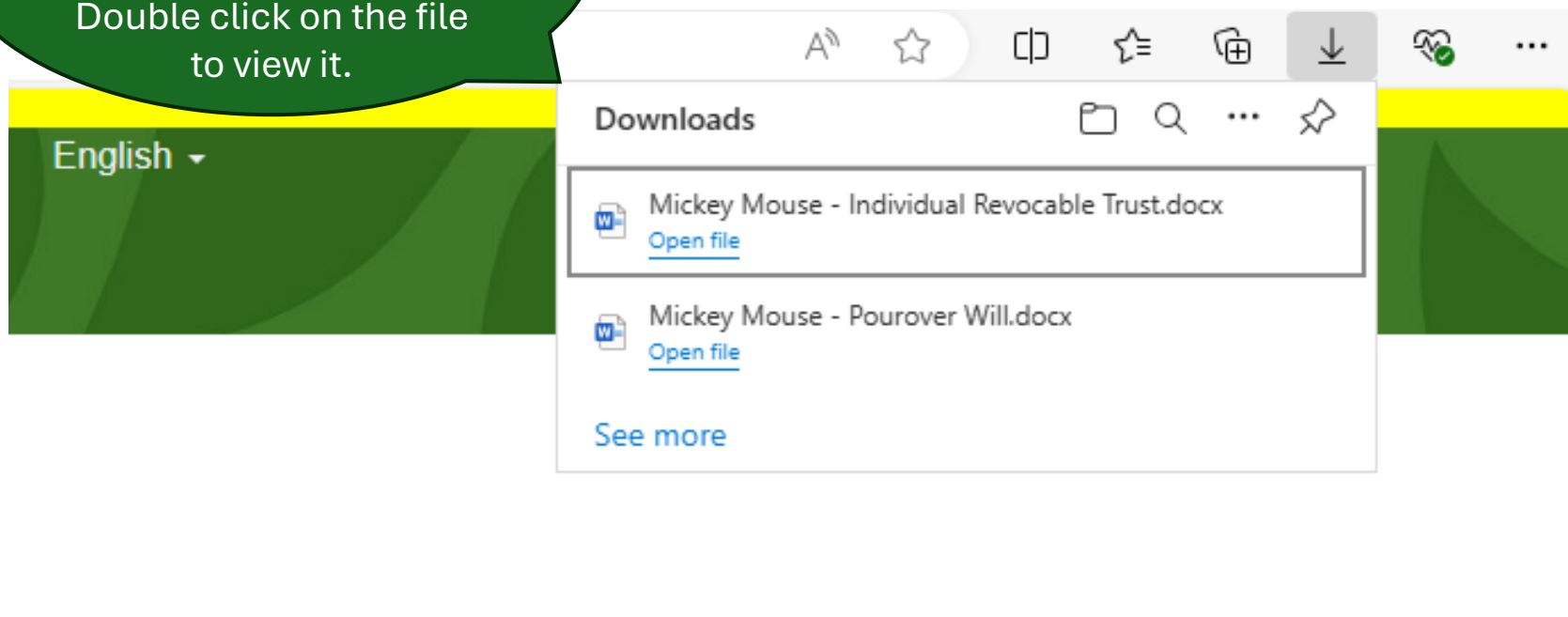
