

There are two ways to execute your LegacyWise estate documents

LegacyWise notary

- LegacyWise will provide two witnesses
- LegacyWise will print your documents for you
- Signing with LegacyWise is free of cost

Any notary

- You may need to bring two disinterested witnesses with you (they cannot be mentioned anywhere in your documents)
- You may need to print your documents
- Some notaries charge fees for notarization
- Most banks will make all of the services available. Most will make them available without charge to their account holders.



What should I bring with me?

- To prove your identity, you will need to bring a valid government issued photo identification with you (driver's license, a state issued photo identification or a passport).
- If you plan on notarizing your documents with a notary other than the one provided by LegacyWise, print out your estate documents and bring them with you to your appointment. A color-capable printer is preferred.
